Audrena Spence was named Executive Director of the Calumet Center of Metropolitan Family Services in 2007. During her tenure as a senior staff member, a \$2.5 million facility was built at its original location to provide better service to more than 7,500 families and individuals annually. Spence joined Metropolitan in 1993 as a social worker.
