and pricing of items at the resale shops

- Keep store looking tidy by straightening shelves, organizing items
- · Cashier duties, if comfortable, as needed
- Ensure confidentiality of clients at all times
- Contact staff as far in advance as possible if unable to provide assistance
- Other duties as negotiated

- Must be friendly and patient
- 2 hour DV101 training encouraged
- Maintain a supportive, empowering and non-judgmental attitude with victims of domestic violence
- Dependable, prompt and mature
- Good organizational skills and ability to be detail oriented
- Ability to work with minimal supervision
- Willingness to accept supervision and guidance
- Bilingual/Bicultural preferred
