Serving Caregivers (60+) Who Are Raising Children



The **Older Caregiver Project** helps older caregivers plan for children's long-term care (permanency planning). Services are for foster, adoptive and guardianship families in which concerns had been raised.

Our services:

- Equip each family with a team of specialists who provide comprehensive assessment services. Assessments include looking at family strengths and needs, and making a recommendation regarding the long-term care and living arrangements of the children.
- Help families to establish a stronger support system through case management and linkages to community resources, and to ensure the well-being and safety of the children and caregivers
- Are free of charge to eligible participants

Eligibility Requirements:

- Caregivers 60+ who have or are seeking to adopt or obtain guardianship of children under the age of 18 years old
- Cook County residents
