Through individualized legal services, the CP4P Justice Corps offers justice-involved adults the opportunity to move past the legal issues and barriers holding them back from success. CP4P Justice Corps assists with employment issues, wage theft, housing, public benefits, crime victim services, human trafficking, immigration, elder law, and domestic violence.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Identify and analyze legal problems and solutions to address barriers to success for clients;
- Participate with attorneys in client interviews and negotiations with adverse parties;
- Research case law and procedure for effective client representation;
- Maintain client files; and
- Work effectively with staff and a diverse client population.

- An interest in community lawyering and restorative justice;
- Strong research and writing skills;
- The ability to communicate effectively with attorneys, clients, and co-workers;
- Strong organizational skills and attention to detail;
